Kind Mayor,

I present you my best regards.

I allow myself to write to present to your attention an issue that, even being important and urgent, remains ignored by the means of information and disregarded by the central authorities of Government. I refer to the Demographic Issue: beyond being a global problem, the high demographic density has in fact heavy consistency in our same Country. Italy has now more of 196 inhabitants for square kilometers, that is equivalent to say that every Italian, ideally distributing the territory of our nation, has at his disposal an area of only 0,50 parts of hectare from which draw the requirements for his life and on which enjoy his individuality and to express his creative skills.

Shortly, I remember that the high density of the population is not only a problem relevant for the ecosystem, certainly thing already serious by itself, but has also heavy effects on the psychophysical health of the person and of the whole social organism, weakening its stability and compromising its safety. I remember also that a high density afflicts not only the large centers, but, having wide and generalized effects, also the small centers, which often undergo the negative effects without in change receiving the benefits.

Our Laboratory produced and collected a rich material on the Demographic Issue, and is happy to put it at your disposal at the Internet address reported above. On our site you will find also news about the initiative of two municipalities in the United States of America. These municipalities, even the USA having a demographic density equal to a quarter of the European one and to a sixth of that Italian, already have pronounced in favor of a stabilization of the population.
